

# Experience the Socorro Islands with Aquatic World on Solmar V

Socorro, part of The Revillagigedos Islands, is located in the eastern Pacific Ocean approximately 250 miles south of Cabo San Lucas, Mexico – at the tip of the Baja peninsula. These islands have been compared to the Galapagos Islands in Ecuador or Cocos Island in Costa Rica because of the big animal encounters they provide. The Revillagigedos Islands consist of 4 islands – [San Benedicto Island](#), [Socorro Island](#), [Roca Partida](#) and Clarion. We simply call them Socorro. They are wild, remote and unpredictable and have been called the Mexican Galapagos.

Join trip leaders Tim and Sharon Corcoran, experienced dive excursion travelers, to Socorro and experience giant mantas, dolphins, 7 different types of sharks and possibly Hump Back Whales. This will be like living a “Planet Earth” episode.
